

Workshops and Sharings on the Island Brac 2011

The Place

The Croatian Island Brac is the focus of a heart centre that channels cosmic love, and distributes the Earth's vital energy across a wide region. The sea plays a vital role in transforming outdated patterns, and a number of impulses for change have manifested close by in the sea as well as on the land. A few of us have started the process of researching the Geomantic configuration of Brac and activating this heart centre. Most felt that this was a time of great transformation- on the land and within.

The Idea

The workshops unite geomancy, personal and collective development and give a framework to deepen our connection with the earth and its beings, ourselves, the community and each other. The underlying intention is to find and live our visions and fully step into our role in the ongoing process of global transformation.

The basic idea is that we are all co-creators of our time together. To facilitate our sharing and explorations I prepare a flexible framework, some impulses and attunements. The call to the island Brac came to me a few years ago in meditation, and I was led to the heart centre there. My role in this process is still unfolding, and it may be linked to my experience as an architect

We will stay at Aloa Camp Site close to Bol, cost approx 10 Euros/Night, plus food, travel and contribution 160/80 Euro, depending on income.

Walking Pilgrimage

12th-16th October

Awakening heart qualities is very high on the agenda in human evolution. Within us we have the ability to create a version of heaven on earth. In this workshop we spend three days walking the land and exploring the heart line across the island. Through this we connect the land and ourselves with cosmic love. We will stay at Apartments Nada in Murvica, cost approx 12 Euros/Night plus food, travel We will stay at Aloa Camp Site close to Bol, cost approx 10 Euros/Night, plus food, travel and contribution 120/60 Euro, depending on income.

We will stay at Apartments Nada in Murvica, cost approx 12 Euros/Night plus food, travel and contribution 160/80 Euro, depending on income.

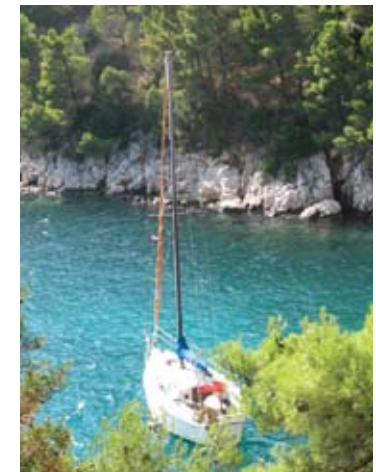
Practicalities
